## **VINEYARD**

Château Tour de Gilet is located in Ludon Médoc, 16 km North of Bordeaux in the Medoc area. The chateau was erected on the foundation of an ancient abbey of the twelfth century. Lots of little streams, called Jalles, cross the vineyard to drain the soil and to improve the quality.

## **VINIFICATION (WINE-MAKING)**

Traditional method in stainless steel vats with controlled temperature to keep the fruit aromas unspoilt. Ageing 18 months in stainless steel vats.

## **TASTING NOTES**

Rich and vibrant offering aromas and flavors of red berries (blackcurrant, blackberry) and hints of cherries.

Excellent balance and silky tannins.

Food pairings: Serve at room temperature with grilled lamb and beef, game, and pasta dishes. Cellaring potential: now to 3 years.
