


Domaine de l'Oriel

RIESLING GRAND CRU "SOMMERBERG"



THE ESTATE: The Weinzorn label, Domaine de l'Oriel, has been producing wine for over 300 years. Domaine de l'Oriel, located in the Alsace region of France. Domaine de l'Oriel produces Pinot Gris, Gewurtraminer, and Riesling, varieties well suited to the growing conditions in Alsace. Claude Weinzorn, son of the late Gerard Weinzorn, has elevated the standard of Domaine de l'Oriel to one of the premier Alsatian vineyards thanks to the unique terroir of his vineyards and Claude's meticulous approach to winemaking. The vineyard operates 9 hectares of land, but due to strenuous standards and growing conditions, Domaine de l'Oriel's yield is only 50 HI/Ha.

THE VINEYARDS: The Sommerberg, the Grand Cru located above Niedermorschwihr that Claude Weinzorn knows by heart and work with passion and love. This soil provides the vineyard soil and weathered granite light, a southern exposure that throat grapes heat and slopes are terraced so pronounced that, hence the name of the wine.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION: 100% Riesling.

VINIFICATION: The harvest is manual before classical vinification and aging in vats on fine lees

TASTING NOTES: The nose is fragrant, about exotic fruits and fish, quite complex. The palate is fat, pretty mellow, with great finesse and a strong minerality.
