Little Star Rosé

Overview: Sourced from the finest vineyards in the south of France, this wine is inspired by a certain Petit Aviator whose author wrote near the beautiful calenques of the Provence region of France. As an homage to the starry nights of this area, we invite you to enjoy the hand-crafted varietals of Dom. de l'Estoile!

Appellation: Indication Géographique Protégée Méditerranée

Varietal Blend: Cabernet, Syrah, Cinsault, and Grenache; this cuvée is produced using meticulously selected wines. The perfecting touches of maturing and blending are carried out in the cellars.

Alcohol: 13%

Tasting Notes: Pale salmon pink in color, with an orange tinge.

Nose shows notes of white flowers that develop into white peach and hints of mandarin. The palate expresses the velvety texture of citrus peel and showcases a balanced but shy minerality and pleasant dryness. Generous flavors of orange skin, ripe peach and kumquat mingle nicely before finishing with refreshing acidity and nuances of Mediterranean sea air.
